As every year, the 91st QATAR PRIX DE L'Arc de Triomphe has been followed by millions of people in 30 countries, more than 600 accredited journalists and 60,000 spectators, who have lived this exciting show from the campus of Longchamp in Paris. Over two days there have been 17 races that have distributed 7.9 million euros in prizes, of which 4 million were delivered in the **Grand Prix of Qatar Arc de Triomphe** and 700,000 euros in the **World Cup Arabian Horses** corresponding to Arab thoroughbreds horses.

The Company operates in the country under the brand Turff Bet & Sports Bar where a good selection to betting on both national and international racetracks.

CODERE in the equestrian world

CODERE manages three racetracks: **Hipódromo de Las Américas** (Mexico), **Hipódromo Presidente Remón** (Panama) and the Hipódromo Nacional de Maroñas (Uruguay) and recently has got the concession from the **Hipódromo de Las Piedras** (Uruguay).

The Company through its experience in the sector is providing success formulas for the revitalization of this activity, which in the late nineties was in recession in Latin America, is regaining its momentum and provides ample opportunities for growth. CODERE addition to horse racing and betting, operates under the *racino model* (combination of horse racing and casinos). This new model allows the installation of gaming machines in the equestrian venues and associated establishments in order to help finance this activity.

CODERE operates racetracks that belong to the International Federation for Equestrian Authorities (IFHA), a prestigious international body that promotes good regulation and best practices in international horse-racing matters.
