At this meeting, an analysis was made of the importance which globalization has on the gambling world by way of the technologies, their impact on this sector and the need of setting out new public policies for controlling this economic activity in the future.

Other panelists also took part at this Meeting, having provided an international view of the public dimension of gambling: José Ramón Romero, Director of the *Loyra Abogados* Law Firm; Julian Harris, from the British law firm of Harris and Hagan –

specializing in gambling; Cecilia Mora-Donatto, from the National Autonomous University of Mexico's Institute for Juridical Research; Francisco Javier Ruiz-Martínez, a Professor from the Carlos III University in Madrid; Victor Daniel Amoroso, the world president of the gaming industry of Union Network International (UNI), -which includes 44 unions-, and Profession I. Nelson Rose, a consultant specialized in Gambling in the U.S.A.

The **22nd World Congress on Political Science** will be dealing throughout these days with a wide variety of issued grouped into the following areas: *Comparative Politics and the political institutions; Sex, religion, identity; International Political Economics; International Relations; Political Conduct or Political Theory.* The different meetings will be held at several venues on the University Complutense of Madrid (UCM) Campus, including the School of Information Science, School of Medicine, School of Pharmacy and the Campus Chancellor's Office.
